RE: Cease & Desist Demand

Dear Mr. Wiegert,

It has come to our attention that you have become a spokesperson in favor of the anti-worker "Yes on A" campaign and are currently appearing in print, radio, video and TV ads for that purpose. In the visual ads, you are prominently display the copyrighted logo of the St. Louis Police Officers Association ("SLPOA") on your clothing. You also reference an association with the SLPOA. As you and the campaign are specifically aware, SLPOA vehemently opposes so called Right to Work (for less) legislation and is working diligently to defeat Proposition A on August 7, 2018. It is patently obvious that you and the campaign are using our copyrighted logo without permission to intentionally mislead Missourians that the SLPOA or its members sanction your anti-worker rhetoric. You and the campaign you are associated with are engaging in copyright infringement and purposely damaging the reputation of our organization.

It is not enough that you are illegally trading on our copyright and the reputation of the SLPOA and our membership of hard working men and women in uniform, but you are doing so to systematically defraud the citizens of Missouri. You and the campaign know full well that you are in no way authorized to speak on behalf of the SLPOA and our members. You and the campaign are specifically aware that you are not authorized to use our copyrighted logo for any purpose. Yet, for this campaign you wear the SLPOA logo at every opportunity to espouse the exact opposite views of our organization. You are not a member of the SLPOA. You were expelled from the organization in 2012 because of unauthorized activities that violated our bylaws. To represent any affiliation with our organization without fully disclosing the fact that you were expelled from the order in disgrace is deceptive.


We hereby demand that you, the campaign and any and all agents, affiliates, funders immediately cease and desist the illegal use of SLPOA's intellectual property and good will. If

you fail to do so, we will be referring this matter to our attorneys to pursue all available legal remedies, including:

- Injunctive relief to prevent further use of our Intellectual property and good will;
- Court orders requiring destruction and/or forfeiture of the infringing materials;
- Monetary damages, including disgorgement of all profits made by you and all others who have profited from the illegal infringement;
- Costs and attorneys' fees incurred to enforce our legal rights; and
- All other remedies provided by federal and state law.

We look forward to your prompt response to this matter.
